#### **EDITORIAL RANT**

In 38 years of KU home football games, including a 62 point loss in a driving rain, I've never sat through a more thoroughly disgusting football "home" experience than the game at Arrowhead. If we play there again, my tickets are for sale, and if it becomes a regular attachment to season tickets, I'll likely be dropping my season tickets and shifting to single game tickets to the real "home" games.

Ignoring the 20,000 plus empty seats and the overall lack of a campus ambiance, the fan experience was terrible. We stood up at least 80 times for the drunks in our row to

stumble over us and up the stairs to the bathroom or to tiptoe back trying to juggle 3-4 plastic cups with yet more beer. There was not one second during the game, including the national anthem, when our aisle wasn't full of others doing the same. Of course, they may not have known the anthem was being played since the acoustics in our part of the stadium were so bad I never heard a single note played by the band. In addition to the visiting team section, the Williams Fund sections were riddled with OU fans who had apparently bought tickets from KU fans who've previously been to Arrowhead and aren't returning. The Oklahoma cretin sitting behind me regularly sprayed spit on the back of my head (easy to notice when you have a bald spot...or two) as he shouted, "MOVE DEM CHAINS!" or "OU, BABYYYYYYY!" My friend, Becky, kept wanting to ask him if he could spell OU. KU keeps saying they want to appeal to the huge KU alumni base in Kansas City. Well, most of that base is in Johnson County, and the drive-time from Johnson County to Arrowhead can only be about 10 minutes less than the drive-time to Lawrence. That 10 minutes is more than offset by the hour we spent trying to get out of the parking lot, and we even left with 3 minutes to go in the game (something I don't do at "home" games).

If I wanted to see college football set in the middle of a concrete pasture with totally inadequate post-game traffic assistance and drunks stumbling up and down the aisles, I suppose I could buy a season ticket about 60 miles up the river.
