Recipe Corner

WARM BACON CHEESE SPREAD –(Dee-Dee Hunt)

Ingredients

1 round loaf (1 pound) sourdough bread	1 ½ tsp Worcestershire sauce
1 pkg (8 oz) cream cheese, softened	¾ pound sliced bacon, cooked and crumbled
1 ½ cups (12 oz) sour cream	½ cup chopped green onions
2 cups (8 oz) shredded cheddar cheese	Assorted crackers

Directions

Cut the top fourth off the loaf of bread; carefully hollow out the bottom, leaving a 1” shell. Cut the removed bread and top of loaf into cubes; set aside.

In a large bowl, beat the cream cheese until fluffy. Add the sour cream, cheddar cheese and Worcestershire sauce until blended; stir in bacon and onions.

Spoon into bread shell. Wrap in a piece of heavy-duty foil and bake at 325 degrees for 1 hour or until heated through.

Serve with crackers and reserved bread cubes.
